RANGE EXCELLENCE SELECTION CRITERIA

The Range Excellence Committee reviews and recognizes rangelands within the state which reflect quality management and good land stewardship. Suggested evaluation criteria include:

- 1. Rangelands in satisfactory condition, improving under current management, and progressing toward management goals.
- 2. Improvement in condition is or can be documented and demonstrated.
- 3. A mix of land uses (livestock grazing, wildlife habitat, recreation, etc.) and ownership result in diversified and sustained benefits.
- 4. The area demonstrates either intensive or extensive management systems on mountain, foothill, riparian, or other range types.
